UPDTAED DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP PROCEDURES



Morning Drop-Off:

- 1) Carline and Student Mason Walk-in Gate can be used for grades TK-8th drop-off.
- 2) **When using the carline, PLEASE do NOT exit your vehicle.**
- 3) UTK/Kinder parents must park on the street and walk their child onto the Kinder Yard. UTK/Kinder Parents are welcome to stay with their child until the class is picked up by their teacher until August 31st, when the Kinder Yard will be closed in the mornings for parents. After August 31st, students can be dropped off through the carline at the Kinder gate or at the Mason Walk-in Gate.
- 4) Sesnon Gate can be used for 2nd - 8th grade drop-off only.

Dismissal Procedures:

- 1) Student Mason Walk-in Gate can be used for grades TK-8th dismissal.
- 2) Carline can be used for grades 2nd – 8th
- 3) **When using the carline, PLEASE do NOT exit your vehicle.**
- 4) UTK/Kinder parents must park on the street and walk to the Kinder Yard to pick-up their child.
- 5) First Grade parents must park on the street and walk to the Main Gate to pick-up their child.
- 6) Second Grade students will be dismissed through the Reunion Gate located directly behind the main office, along the carline, next to the field. 2nd grade students can meet parents in the carline, at the Mason walk-in gate or at the Reunion Gate.
- 7) Sesnon Gate carline can be used for 3rd - 8th grade pick-up.
