



Student Vaccination Requirement:

All students who are 12 years of age and older must receive their first Covid-19 vaccine dose by no later than November 21, 2021 and their second dose by no later than December 19, 2021. All other students must receive their first vaccine dose by no later than 30 days after their 12th birthday, and their second dose by no later than 8 weeks after their 12th birthday. See p. 8-12. PSAT 8/9 Test Date Wednesday, January 26th

The PSAT 8/9 will be offered to students currently enrolled in 8th grade. PSAT 8/9 is offered to students that are interested in getting a baseline prior to the PSAT NSMQT in high school. PSAT 8/9 is an optional test. Students that register will be taking the exam during class time on Wednesday, January 26th. Students will be excused from class during testing hours. PSAT 8/9 takes 3 – 4 hours total.

PSAT 8/9 measures what students are learning in school and helps determine if they are on track for high school and beyond. It also helps students build confidence in preparation for the SAT, choose high school courses, and explore career options by connecting students to Career Finder, a tool offered by College Board.

LAUSD Student Vaccination Requirement - see p. 8 - 13

The science is clear – vaccinations are an essential part of protection against COVID-19. In order to reduce transmission and ensure students can remain on campus in the safest possible environment and receive the best education possible, Los Angeles Unified is now requiring all students who are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccination to be fully vaccinated by Monday, January 10, 2022, unless they have a qualified exemption. Proof of vaccination must be uploaded to the <u>Daily Pass</u>.

All students who are 12 years of age and older must receive their first vaccine dose by no later than November 21, 2021 and their second dose by no later than December 19, 2021. All other students must receive their first vaccine dose by no later than 30 days after their 12th birthday, and their second dose by no later than 8 weeks after their 12th birthday.

Students and families that have questions or concerns regarding the vaccine are encouraged to call our family hotline at 213-443-1300 and review our Frequently Asked Questions.



What to Know about Student Vaccinations at Los Angeles Unified

The science is clear – vaccinations are a safe, effective and essential part of protection against COVID-19.

The benefits of the vaccine continue to outweigh the risks and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that everyone 12 and older get vaccinated.





How to Get Your Child Vaccinated at Los Angeles Unified

My child has been vaccinated, but I have not submitted proof of vaccination to Los Angeles Unified:

- Take a photo of the vaccine card that you received the day your child was vaccinated.
- Log onto the Daily Pass to submit a photo of your eligible child's vaccine card. For help, review our step-by-step guide here: <u>bitly/DPUploadExtVacc1Pager</u>.
- 3. Upload image and press submit. Please note, approval for this process can take up to a week.

My child has not been vaccinated:

- Visit the District's COVID-19 Vaccine Appointment Page (<u>achieve lausd net/covidvaccineappt</u>) to review the student vaccination initiative and learn how to prepare for your student's vaccine.
- Book a vaccination appointment.

Option 2: Find a clinic near you!

Hours, locations, and instructions for appointments through trusted health partners (bit.ly/LAUnifiedClinicPartners) or LA County Sites (bit.ly/LACountyVaxSites). After your child is vaccinated at one of these sites, make sure to follow steps 1-3 above to upload proof onto the Daily Pass.

For Children with Qualified Medical Exemptions or Conditional Admissions:


Los Angeles Unified families can submit qualified medical exemptions. Please note that similar to other childhood vaccines, there are no personal or religious belief exemptions. Families can obtain a copy of the exemption letter from their school site at any time and can complete and upload the form for District review onto the Daily Pass starting October 20.

Children in foster care, experiencing homelessness, migrants, in a military family or who have an IEP may qualify for conditional admissions.

Together, we can help keep our school communities healthy by getting vaccinated.




COVID SAFETY: Please have a conversation with your child/ren about the safety of wearing a mask properly. Students may remove their mask during nutrition and lunch while at the table to eat or drink. Mask must be worn properly for the remainder of the school day, including during recess, lunch and physical activities and PE for middle school.

Covid-19 Testing will continue with the LAUSD Mobile Unit on campus weekly on Mondays and Tuesdays. If you would like to have your child Covid-19 tested on campus, students will need a Covid-19 Testing Consent. Parents can give consent on the Dailypass (see instruction) or to print, Click HERE for Consent Form. Once the Covid-19 test consent is given, the school site is responsible for testing students. If you are having your child/ren tested at an outside testing agency, test results must be uploaded to dailypass.lausd.net weekly to keep Dailypass current to be on campus. This week, LAUSD Testing Unit will not be on campus. If you would like to test your child for COVID, Northridge Middle School and West Valley Occupational Center will be open on Tuesday, September 7th, from 9 am to 7 pm. On campus testing will resume September 13th and 14th.

The COVID-19 School Report Card dashboard provides daily updates on the reopening status and COVID-19 testing results for the staff and students participating in-person instruction on our campus. What is the Parent Portal and how can I access it?

The <u>Parent Portal</u> is a website where families may access their child's information and also access resources. The site includes direct link to Schoology and the Daily Pass. Also included in the site is your child's attendance, access to grades and assignments, and access to update emergency contact information to name a few. To open an account visit https://achieve.lausd.net/Page/10470. The webpage includes information about the Parent Portal and resources to help you practice its use. Make sure to click on the "Log In/Register" button which will take you to the official log in page. If you do not have an account click on "Register for an account." The page will ask for your name and email. Once you register an email will be sent to you where you will be asked to establish a password. This account is solely for your use. Your spouse/partner must open their own account to access student information.

Where can I access my Parent Portal PIN?

Parents may access their Parent Portal PIN by contacting their school site and come to the main office or email Mrs. Endler at jennifer.endler@lausd.net to request a Zoom Appointment to verify a valid ID.
