DRESS CODE POLICY 2022 – 2023

Dress for Success at PRCS!

At Porter Ranch Community School, we believe that students should focus on school work and not what to wear to school. It is this reason we adopted a dress code which will be required **every day**.

The following is our Dress Code:

- All clothing must be school appropriate.
- Any graphic or logo images on clothing must be school appropriate.
- All shorts must have at least a 3" inseam. All private areas must be covered.
- Shoes must be closed toed and students can run and play in them safely.
- There are no low cut/crop top t-shirts allowed.
- No baggy pants or low hanging pants.
- Students' underwear/undergarment should not be visible.
- Excessive jewelry can be dangerous and should not be worn.
- Hats can only be worn outside in the sun and cannot be backwards. Hats may not have inappropriate logos on them.

Students are allowed to wear sun-protective clothing, including hats, for outdoor use during the school day only on the yard.

"Encouraged Dress Code:"

- White, blue or black polo shirts
- Black, blue or Khaki slacks or jeans
