Dear 8<sup>th</sup> grade parents/guardians,

Plans are underway for the "End of the Year" activities and culmination ceremony for your 8<sup>th</sup> grade students! Listed below are the details of our upcoming activities. Our 8<sup>th</sup> grade \*\* Grad Night and Formal require pre-sale tickets.

**Friday April 8<sup>th</sup>:** Periods 1-3. Students will take their formal portraits and panoramic picture. There will be a fee and order forms will be sent home closer to the date.

**Friday, May 20<sup>th</sup>:** \*\* Universal Grad Bash- Universal Studios. Ticket includes admission and transportation. This is a student only event in California middle schools. There will be adult chaperones on site. Students must meet \*ON PAR requirements to attend as well as clear all debts. (Chromebook & textbooks) Deadline to turn payment in is Friday, April 29<sup>th</sup>. Please make checks out to PRC PTA. Registration forms will be sent out in February. *The cost is \$70.00 per ticket.* For grad night information, please contact Alice Lee, 8<sup>th</sup> grade coordinator at [alice534@hotmail.com](mailto:alice534@hotmail.com). This is not an LAUSD sponsored event. Ticket is non-refundable.

Per LA County's Public Health order, at Universal Studios, all persons ages 5+ must be prepared to show proof of full FDA or WHO approved COVID-19 vaccination (a full 14 days after final dose was administered), or a negative test taken within 24 hours (antigen i.e., "rapid" test) or 48 hours (PCR test) of visit, prior to entry to the theme park. A COVID-19 self-test, sometimes referred to as a "home test", is not acceptable. If you do not follow the above guidelines, your child will not be permitted to attend and there are no refunds.

**Monday, June 6<sup>th</sup>:** Period 1. 8<sup>th</sup> grade Honor Roll Assembly. Honor Roll awards, cords, and plaques will be handed out in the MPR. This is a student only event. Invitations will be sent home in May.

**Tuesday, June 7<sup>th</sup>:** \*\*8<sup>th</sup> grade formal at Porter Valley Country Club. 6:00 – 9:00pm. Tickets include dinner, DJ, photo booth, and more! This is a faculty chaperone event only. The formal is optional for those students who would like to attend. Parents are responsible for transportation for pick up and drop off. Students must meet \*ON PAR requirements to attend as well as clear all debts. (Chromebooks & textbooks.) *The cost is \$65.00 per ticket.* Please make checks out to PRC PTA. Registration forms will be sent out in March. This is not an LAUSD sponsored event. Ticket is non-refundable.

**Friday, June 10<sup>th</sup>:** Culmination at PRCS. 9:00am. Students must wear appropriate attire for school culmination. This includes no strapless dresses/tops, skirts/dresses must be fingertip length, no hats, and boys need to wear collared shirts and no shorts.

Students must meet our current 8<sup>th</sup> grade culmination requirements. June 10<sup>th</sup> is a minimum day.

\*ON PAR is passing all classes and no more than 2 U's in Work Habits and no more than 2 U's in Cooperation.

\*\* This is a voluntary event. Those that choose to participate understand the possibility of COVID19 transmission. This is not an LAUSD sponsored event. COVID19 positive students and unvaccinated close contacts will not be able to participate on the day of culmination.
